

2017-2018 Summary of the School Trust Lands Plan Final Report

At Kanab High School, last year’s Community Council created two goals to support our School Improvement Plan and student learning for 2017-18. These goals utilized our Trust Lands Funds to create learning opportunities and supports for our students. One of our goals was to assist students become or remain successful in their coursework. An important component of the plan was continued funding of paraprofessionals in the remediation and independent education programs. Our paraprofessionals assisted students in credit recovery, as well as, provided academic support and assistance. Students received tutoring, help with time and task management, and teacher communication. Over 127 students received assistance earning make-up credit or successfully completing coursework. Trust Land monies were used for the salaries of our para-professionals, the purchase 20 student chrome books, and a software site license for the KHS Literacy program.

One measurement of program success is the KHS graduation rate. The rate for the 17-18 school year was 98%. Students earned 7 credits in the credit recovery program and 90% of students receiving assistance through the Independent Education course successfully completed coursework during the school year. Sage proficiency rates for 2018 were 44% English, 42% Math, and 37% Science. Proficiency rate increases and student academic achievement will continue to be a focus in our School Improvement and Trust Lands plans.

Our second goal was to provide interested students with an Aviation Technology course. Trust Land funds were used for the salary to hire the instructor and purchase supplies for the course. Students enrolled in the course were prepared with foundational coursework that prepared them to complete private pilots training after graduation. All students that enrolled in the course received credit.

We appreciate our School Community Council for their time and service in allocating the \$48,707 of trust land funds. Trust Land funding provides educational opportunities, supports learning and helps ensure student success.
