- III. Agenda Topics
  - 1. Calendar December calendar was discussed mostly focusing on this week's sub for santa activities

    - d. Cameras in Classrooms Superintendent talked to all of the faculties and to explain the cameras in classrooms. They will be mounted in the back of the room and linked to the sound of the teachers' microphones. Teachers will be able to upload lessons taught onto canvas for absent students. The overall feeling of the council members was supportive of cameras and felt the school cameras would protect teachers.
    - e. End of Semester Policy for Concurrent Enrollment Policy change suggested to let students enrolled in college classes be excused from attending after college class finals. The council members support this change.
