2. Lisa motioned to approve minutes from March meeting, Natali seconded the motion and all were in favor
3. Agenda Topics
  - a. Discussion
    - i. State track several first place medals, boys overall was 2nd place, and girls were 3rd place
    - ii. Scholarship night - Chad discussed some of the big accomplishments for the night those included valedictorian John Riordan, salutatorian Kevin Luo, 4 students earning associate's degree, 11 students earning GE certificates, Carmen Watson foundation donated \$22,500 and other donations made to the Kane schools foundation for all 17 students that applied
    - iii. Graduation policy changes - the council agrees all graduates should wear red gowns, no decorating of the caps, and leis will be limited to one for cultural/religious reasons except for students that earned medals and/or chords
    - iv. Dress code - the council does not see the need to change any dress codes
    - v. TSSA - Teacher Student Success Act - \$54,000 total to be dispersed as follows: \$2,000 professional development, \$2,000 technology hardware, \$24,000 math prep wages, \$10,000 BYU independent student aide wages, \$10,000 instruction materials, \$2,000 university field trips, \$1,300 peer tutors, \$2,700 miscellaneous incentive supplies. April motioned to approve the allocations of the funds, Lexie seconded the motion, all were in favor
