IV. Reports & Discussion

1. Calendar Items

- a. State Golf - Ray Capson took 2nd in the State!
- b. Region & Divisionals – Cross Country – Our teams performed well.
- c. Homecoming Report – Everything went really well. It was a smooth week. There were some hang ups at the parade with safety but it worked out.
- d. All-State Choir - Mrs. Terry took 4 kids up to SLC to perform in the Tabernacle. They performed with students from throughout the state and had a great experience.

2. Counseling – Mr. Castagno

The Pre-ACT was taken recently by the freshman and sophomores. Students receive certificates and medals if they perform well in comparison with students throughout the state.

3 students went on a tour of Southwest Tech with Mr. Castagno to visit Southwest Tech. 7 students are currently going over during the week to certify as Pharmacy Techs, Automotive, and Culinary Professionals

College App week is coming up. Students will be able to apply for colleges in the state of Utah. Colleges come and help students apply.

Athletic Director, Kade Glazier, visited concerning the Code of Conduct in Athletics.

There is no rule as to when a student joins a team. They could come and join a team at any point during the season (as long as they hadn't been playing at another school during the season, in which case they would need to sit out 50% of the time). This applies from the same sport to the same sport.

If an athlete joins a team late, there may be repercussions on the other athletes. The coach will decide if an athlete is allowed to join and may expect a try out. Some coaches need to recruit athletes and therefore the try out experience could vary from sport to sport.

A KHS coaching handbook is provided to all coaches hired by the district, however coaches are given leeway as to how to conduct try outs, practices, & carry out games. In the future, there will be additions as to proper communication formats.
