- a. Report on start of year 314 students, good start
- b. Tech opportunities Culinary Arts, Health Science, Medical Terminology, Info Technology, Veterinarian Tech, Software Development, In CC @ SWT- B days Auto, Welding, Robotics, Pharmacy Tech, Medical Assisting some students wanted to take their own cars to CC but they are not allowed to do that, they must ride the bus
- c. Review /Vote on Trustland Amendment Mr Stewart proposed the following amendment

We will switch the salary and benefits expenses from an attendance/behavior intervention para to paraprofessionals to assist in the Physical Education weights course. Paras will assist Mr. B. Orton in teaching large classes, proper lifting techniques, safe use of exercise equipment, and progress/participation monitoring. Paras will assist in the boys' and girls' classes. The estimated expense is \$6,000. We

would like to use the remaining portion of the funding for the salary and benefits of the broadcast technology teacher to support our broadcasting program which is run in conjunction with the Career and Technical Education Broadcast and Digital Media courses. The estimated expense is \$4,000.

- We discussed the benefits of the amendment and the large 30+ students class sizes. The amendment gives the students the direct instruction they need for the individual levels they are at. April motioned to accept the amendment, Shellie Stewart seconded the motion and all present were in favor. Mr Stewart emailed the proposed amendment and Josh Porter, Lexie Little, and Kacie Troy all acknowledged they were unable to make the meeting but told Mr Stewart they were in favor of the change.
- d. Library materials HB a new house bill listed books that were considered pornographic in nature. Mrs. Wheeler the librarian went through the list and we do not have any of the listed books in our circulation currently.
- e. Open Discussion Lexie had emailed Mr Stewart her concerns about student athletes using drugs and showed interest in adapting a drug testing policy. We discussed the pros and cons of testing students involved in any extracurricular activity but decided we need to discuss it more at the next meeting.
- f. Trevor motioned to dismiss, Lisa seconded the motion and all were in favor
